<u>People Analytics: Changing Our Mindset from Measurement</u> to What Matters

Dr. Wesson will provide an overview of HR Analytics. Although we constantly hear the term "people analytics" in today's HR terminology, most people are still unclear as to what the term actually represents. The session will cover what the term "people analytics" represents to various stakeholders. He'll show how using data evaluating different processes as well as using numbers related to turnover can help an organization learn and adjust. He will introduce three ways that people analytics should change your mindset about how you approach human resource management and your day to day work. These adjustments can affect the quality of hire, improve the effectiveness of onboarding, heighten engagement, and reduce turnover. Lastly, he will also discuss how people analytics can fit into your career and development as a leader in the HR field.

SPEAKERS BIO

Dr. Michael Wesson is an Associate Professor and Director of Management Graduate Education at Texas A&M University's Mays Business School. Dr. Wesson currently teaches MBAs, PMBAs, EMBAs and MS/HRM students in the areas of leadership, human resource management and organizational behavior. Dr. Wesson's teaching has been recognized with several teaching grants including the Texas A&M University Center for Teaching Excellence Montague Scholar. He is also co-author of a textbook on Organizational Behavior.

His specific research interests focus on the areas of recruitment, selection, socialization, compensation, and leadership. His research articles have been published in numerous top-tier journals.

Prior to returning to school for his doctoral degree at Michigan State University, Michael worked as a human resources manager for Baker Hughes, Inc. He has served as a consultant to the automotive supplier, oil and gas, consulting, and technology industries in areas dealing with HR analytics, organizational change, selection, onboarding, leadership development, compensation, and turnover.


