### How to Beat Stress Presenter: Dr. Dominique Chlup

Dr. Dominique Chlup works with highly accomplished academics, creatives, and executives who decide it's time to turn their unmet dream into real life. Eventually, it occurred to Dominique that she didn't want to continue life as a professor. She ended up walking away from her tenured academic position to become a coach. She now helps other high achieving professionals uncover and map the action steps to finally make what they've dreamed about actually happen. She supports herclients as they write the books they've always wanted to write, start new chapters in their careers, move to countries that call them, and live the lives they've always wanted.
